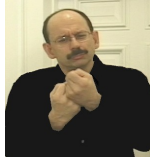

What is the Deaf Services Team?

The Deaf Services Team is a group of hearing and deaf counselors and case managers who know American Sign Language and can help you with mental health problems.



What are Mental Health Problems?

Some problems can be:

- feeling sad
- feeling nervous
- feeling afraid
- feeling confused
- arguing with other people
- wanting to run away and hide

Problems can happen:

- with your family
- with your friends
- with your job

What kind of counseling do you have?

- you can meet alone with a counselor
- you can come with your husband or wife or partner
- parents and children can come together

What will happen?

You and the counselor will talk

- the counselor will give you ideas
- the counselor will give you advice
- you and the counselor will solve problems together

Will I have to take medicine?

You will decide this yourself. Some medicines may help you. There are doctors and nurses here that can give you medicine, if you want. It is your decision.

How much does it cost?

We accept Medicaid, Medicare, and most insurance. They will pay for most of it. If you don't have insurance, you can still get services. The cost depends on how much money you earn. If you don't earn much money, the cost will be very low or free.

Where is it?

The Deaf Services Team is in Nashua at Greater Nashua Mental Health Center, but they drive to offices in Manchester, Concord, Portsmouth, and places all over New Hampshire.

Will everybody know my business?

NO! A team of a counselor, medical staff, and maybe other people will be working with you. Team members will talk about the best way we can help you, but we can't talk about your business outside of the team. We are not even allowed to tell other people that we know you, unless you say it's OK.



What about an interpreter?



Sometimes you may want to meet with a person who works here, but does not know how to sign, like a doctor or nurse. We will find an interpreter for that meeting, and we will pay for the interpreter.
